PURPOSE: The Friends of the Stillwater Library Scholarship was established in 2018. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are enrolled as high school seniors or home-schooled within the Stillwater Central School District who will be enrolled in further technical training education or entering a technical/trade career.

EDUCATIONAL AWARD: The Friends of the Stillwater Library awards based on a comprehensive process. Educational Award funds are distributed directly to the recipient with proof of completion of a BOCES Trade Program. The Friends of the Stillwater Library Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

RECIPIENTS: Created to honor Tom Mellon - a man who embraced his local community with his time and carpentry skills. In 2021, The Friends of the Stillwater Library will award the Thomas Mellon Memorial Educational Merit Award (Vocational/Trade) in the amount of **\$250.00**.

CRITERIA

- Applicant must be on track to complete or have completed, a trade school program that leads to an apprenticeship, further education, or employment in their field of study with a GPA of 75% or above.
- Applicant must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Preference will be given to high school seniors and students in a BOCES program within the Stillwater Central School District.
