PURPOSE: The Friends of the Stillwater Library Scholarship was established in 2018. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are enrolled as high school seniors or home-schooled within the Stillwater Central School District who show commitment and service to the community.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: The Friends of the Stillwater Library awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Scholarship funds are distributed directly to the recipient, with proof of post-secondary schooling acceptance. The Friends of the Stillwater Library Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

RECIPIENTS: In 2020, The Friends of the Stillwater Library will award a scholarship:

- The Friends of the Stillwater Model Volunteer Scholarship (Volunteerism), in the amount of \$500.00: Created to encourage and recognize volunteerism in the local community.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college, university or technical school for the upcoming academic semester.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Preference will be given to high school seniors and home-schooled students within the Stillwater Central School District.

- Official proof of academic standing.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies (if not yet awarded, a certificate of intent to award will be presented pending proof of acceptance letter).
