Carolyn "Tukey" Brewster- She has become a Physical Ed. Teacher. She Gives special classes in Ju Jitsu.

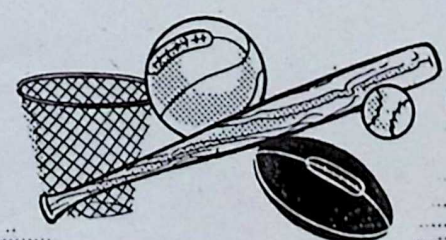
Earl "Wheezer" Crandall- He has become a well known lecturer. His favorite subject is "Woman :the Weaker Sex".

Arthur "Artie" Gannon- He has finally become Jimmy Linche's partner. Ows his success to the Ford Car.

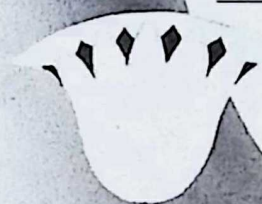
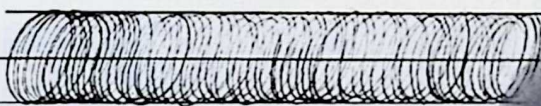
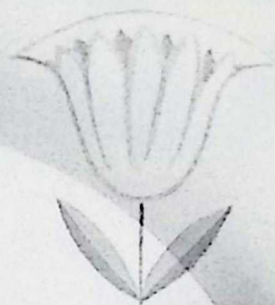

The musical organizations of the school have been kept busy this year. The band participated in many parades, including those at Stillwater, Mechanicville and Corinth.

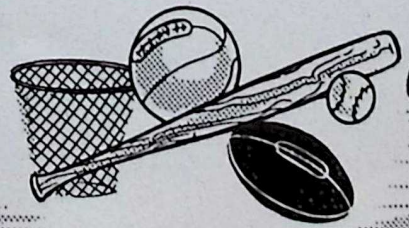
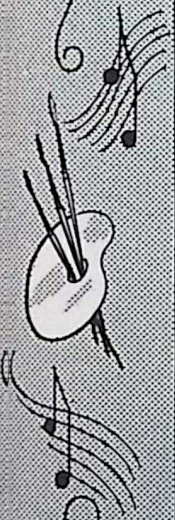
The band has also given the football and basketball teams excellent support by playing for the various games.

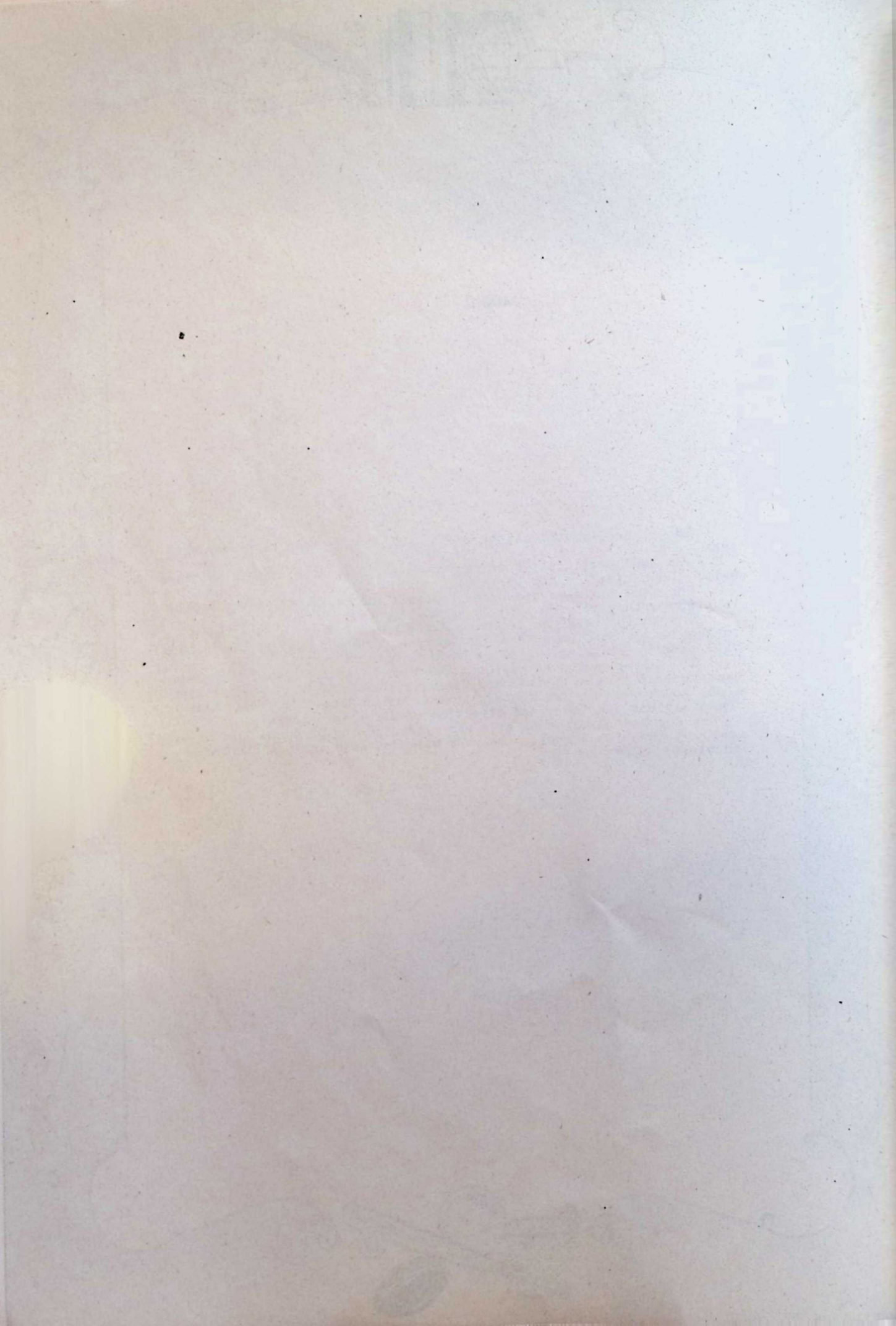
The Junior Band has improved rapidly and has given excellent help to the Senior Band on several occasions. No doubt many of its members will soon be transferred to the higher organization.

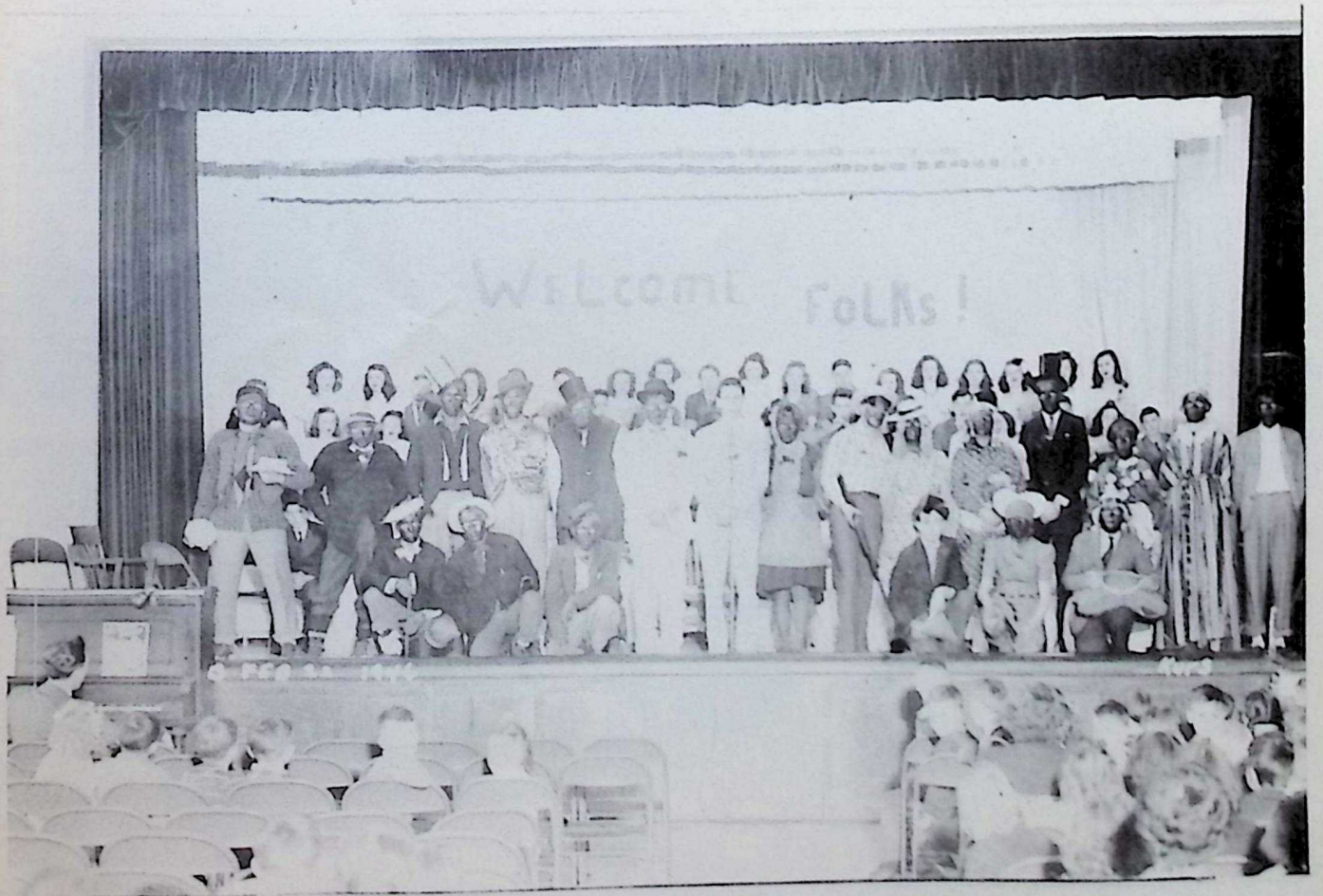
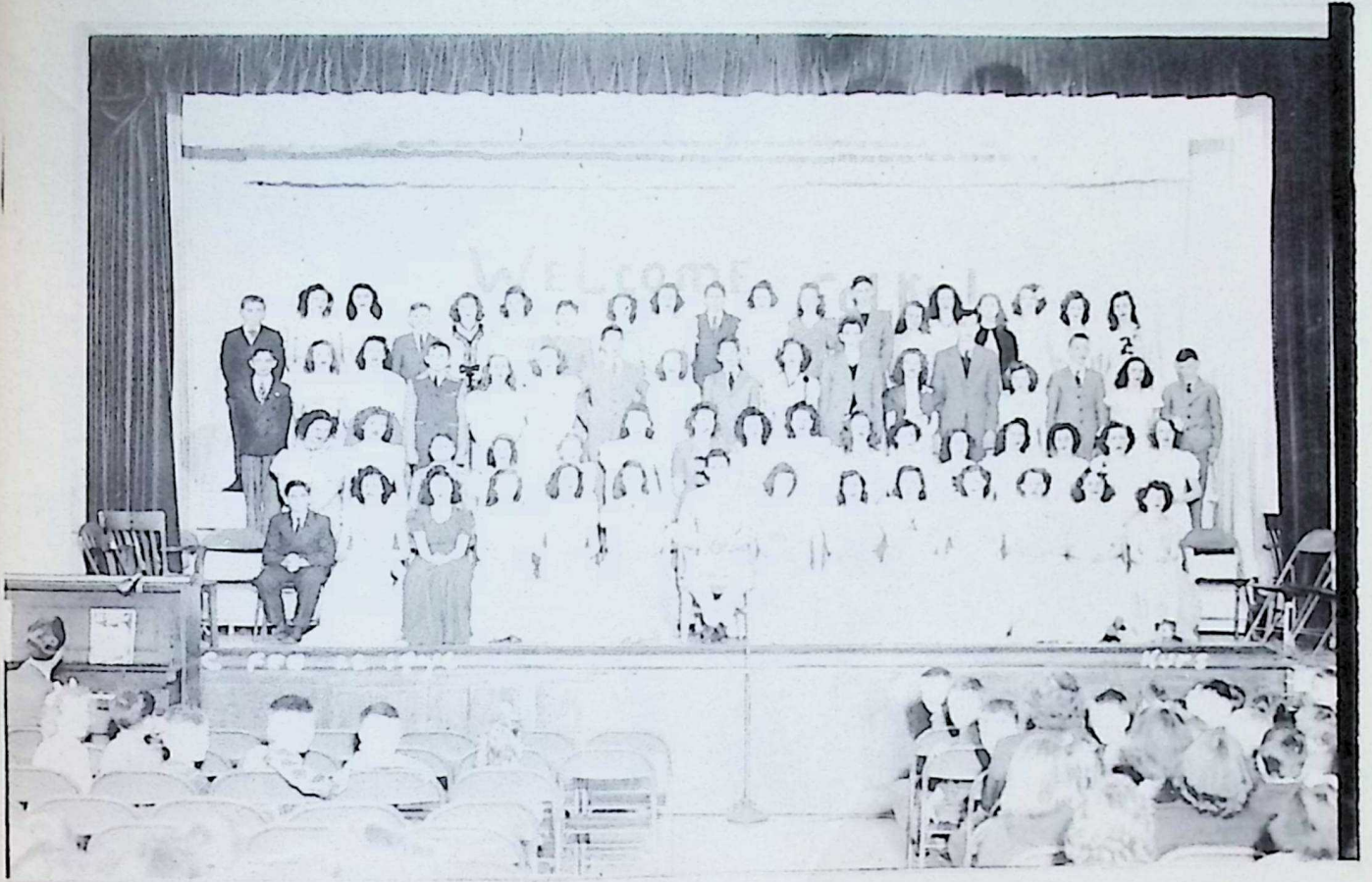
A successful minstrel show was presented the 22nd and 23rd of February by the high school. The show was presented again April 5th at Schuylerville by request.

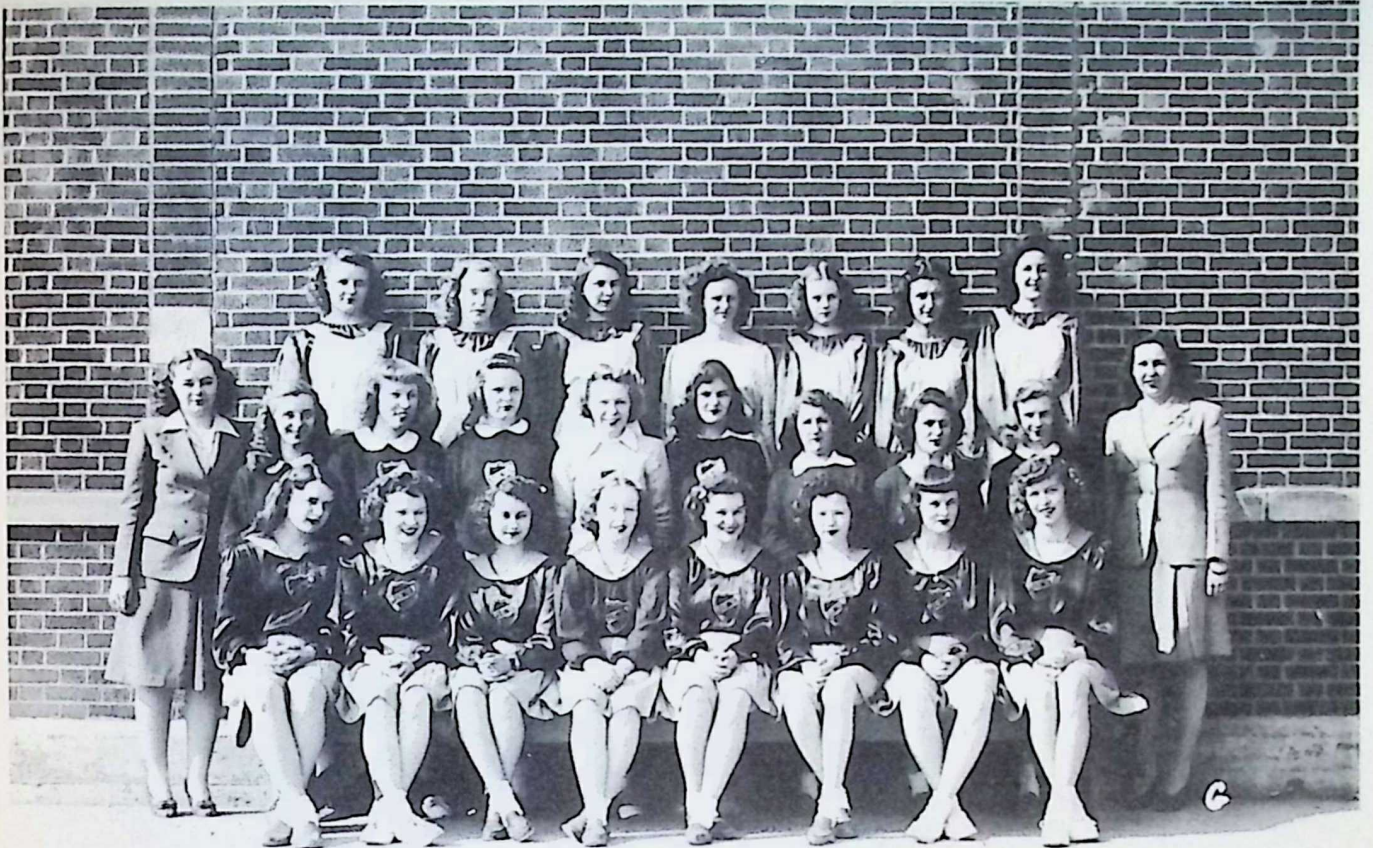

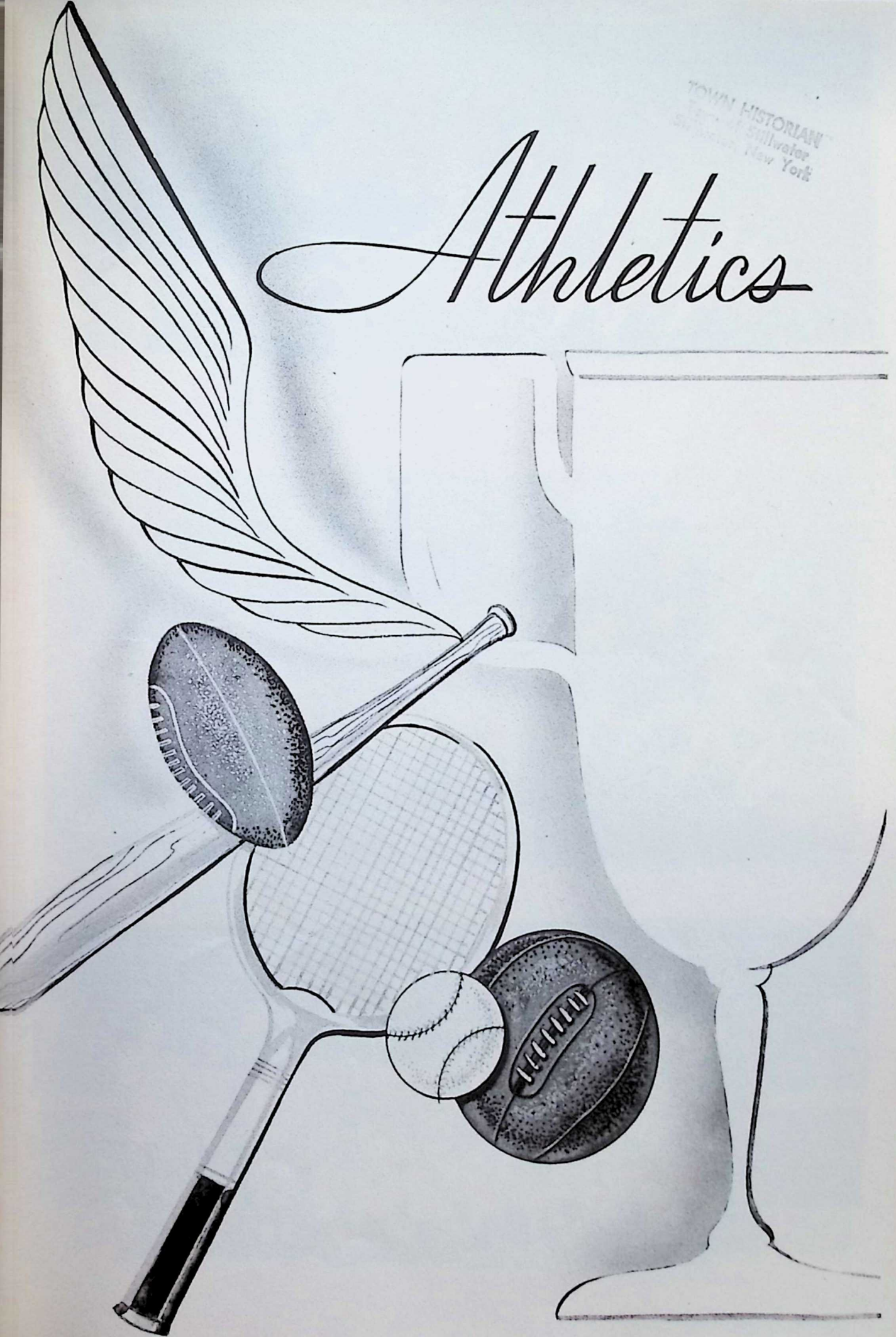

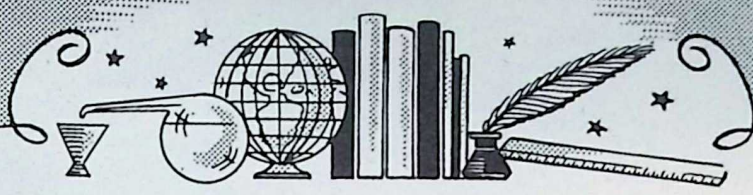

### BASKETBALL

On November 15, Coach Ted Hoffa called for the first basketball practice of the season. Those who reported were "Lou" Bailey, "Hank" Stockwicz, "Cuzzy" Connor, "Jack" Connor, "Zigo" Canary, "Bill" Lake, "P-Nuts" Kinisky, "John" Bochetti, "Amos" Carpenter, "Dick" Tanner, and "Spook" Nelson. About 20 boys reported for the Jay-V's.

After three weeks of conditioning and fundamentals we were ready for our first game with Corinth, but we ended up on the losing end of 27-21 score. The next game saw us nosing out Burnt Hills, eventually the county champs. We were defeated by Scotia in a hard fought contest, by a 30-26 score.

The following week saw us beating South High 34-21 and losing a slow game to Mechanicville on the "Match Box" court 33-19. Then we routed Schuylerville and Mechanicville by the scores of 30-20 and 33-30 respectively. In the next encounter we were plowed under by a strong Hoosick Falls outfit 39-24 score. And we lost the next four games to Greenwich, Ballston, Burnt Hills, and Cornith. Then we won a game by downing Greenwich 29-24 and the following week we lost a hard fought battle to Schuylerville 30-24. We travelled to Scotia where we took the worst beating of the season by a score of 33-29. Ballston edged us out by a score of 46-31. In our last two games of the season we were turned back by Hoosick Falls and South High.

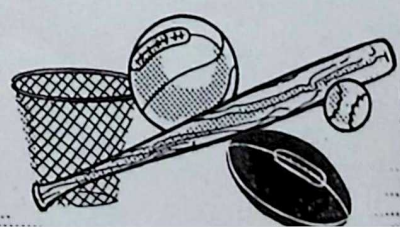
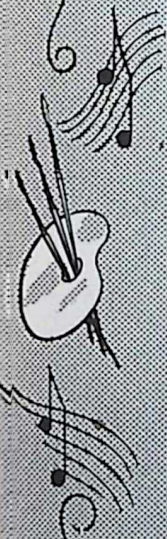
### HIGHLIGHTS

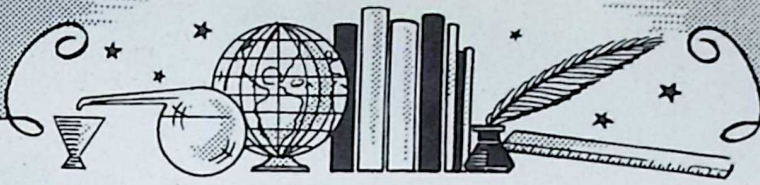
Due to the illness of the players during the season it made it very difficult for the players to play a real good game.

### FOOTBALL

Soon after school started, Coach Ted Hoffa, former Ballston mentor, called for football candidates. The first night of practice saw about 20 men answering the call with most of the players veterans of the Gridiron. After weeks of hard and intensive training, Coach Hoffa rounded out a hard hitting team, with "Amos" Carpenter at the center slot, "Hank" Stockwicz and "Zigo" Canary at left and right ends respectively, "Dick" Tanner calling the signals, "Cuzzy" Connor at half-back and "Lou" Bailey at the fullback position.

The boys were varing to go, and they showed it by trouncing Cambridge 44 to 7. It was Stillwater's first win and its first start in League competition since 1943. Bailey paced Stillwater to its first Victory of the season, by scoring 4 of Stillwater's touchdowns. Canary and Antlick also crossed the line for touchdowns.

The Stillwater men were all ready to tear into the Ballston six, but it wasn't as easy as the lads thought. Ballston had a tough team, but Stillwater had a tougher one and they showed this by Lou Bailey's, plunging across the line and adding the point which tied the game up at 7 all. The in the last period, Bailey dropped a 30 yard pass into the hands of Canary, but they missed the point. Stillwater came through with their second straight game of the season, by a score of 13 to 7. The next game saw Hoosick Falls trouncing the Hoffa men 26 to 7. Stillwater scored its second canto while Bailey flung a pass to Canary.

Stillwater then traveled to Greenwich and were turned back on the short end of 30 to 15. Bailey and Tanner clicked for many passes with one food for a touchdown. Stillwater's other tally came in the last period when Connors recovered a Greenwich fumble over the goal. The following week the Stillwater griders took the road and went to Southhigh where they took their worst beating of the season 49 to 6. Stillwater's lone score came when Bailey broke loose and ran 30 yards for a touchdown.

On November 5, Salem came to Stillwater for our last game of the season. The game was played on a very muddy field which made it hard for either team to score, but Salem came through in the third quarter to give the hard fighting Stillwater six its fourth straight defeat in a row.

Stillwater ended its gridiron season with two wins and four defeats, and ended up in fifth place in the County League.

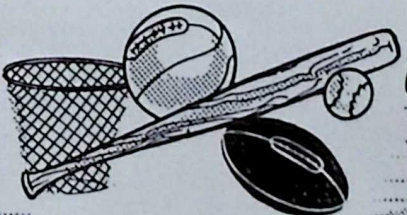

Cuzzy Connor did a noteworthy job as half-back.

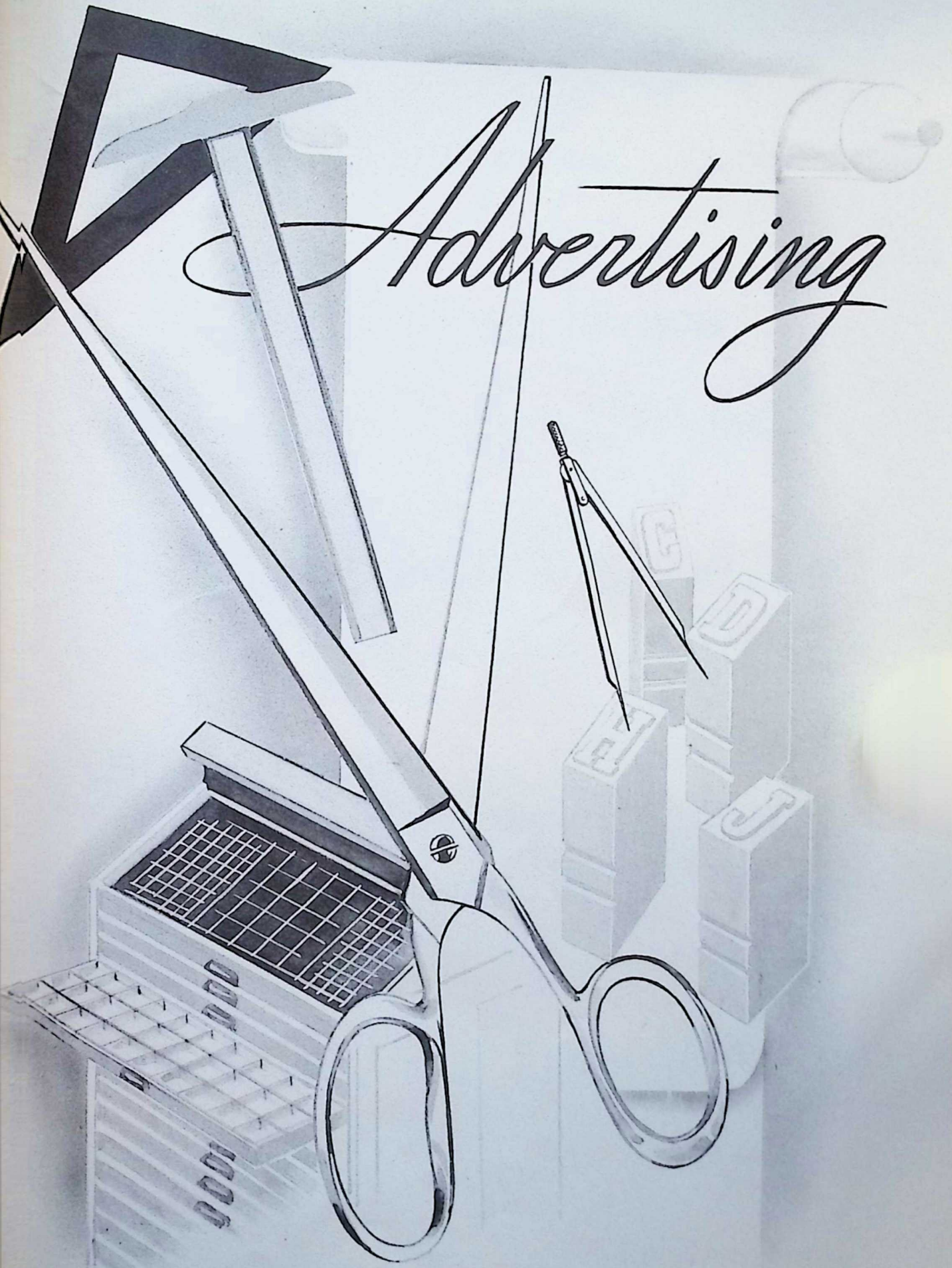

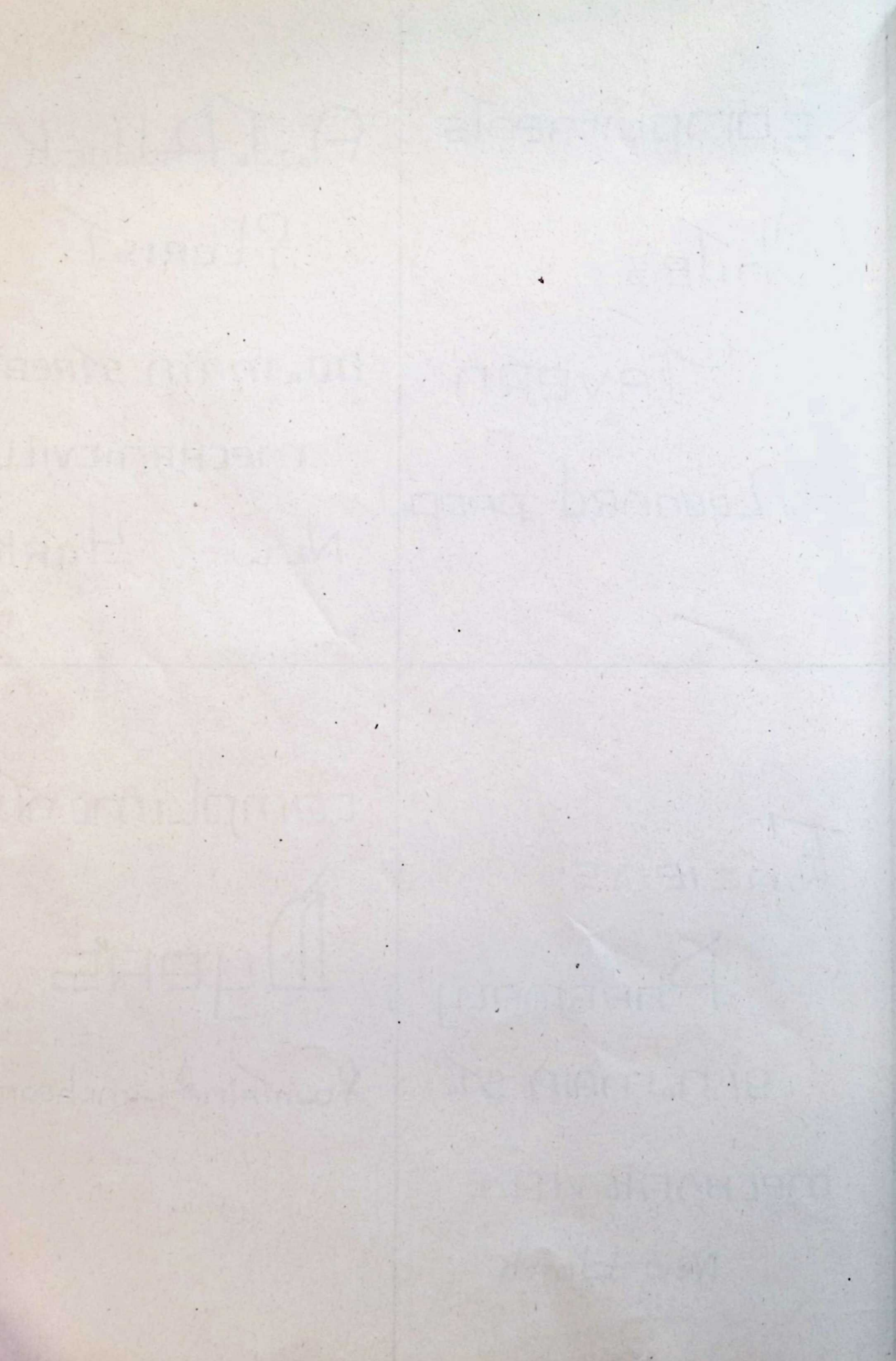

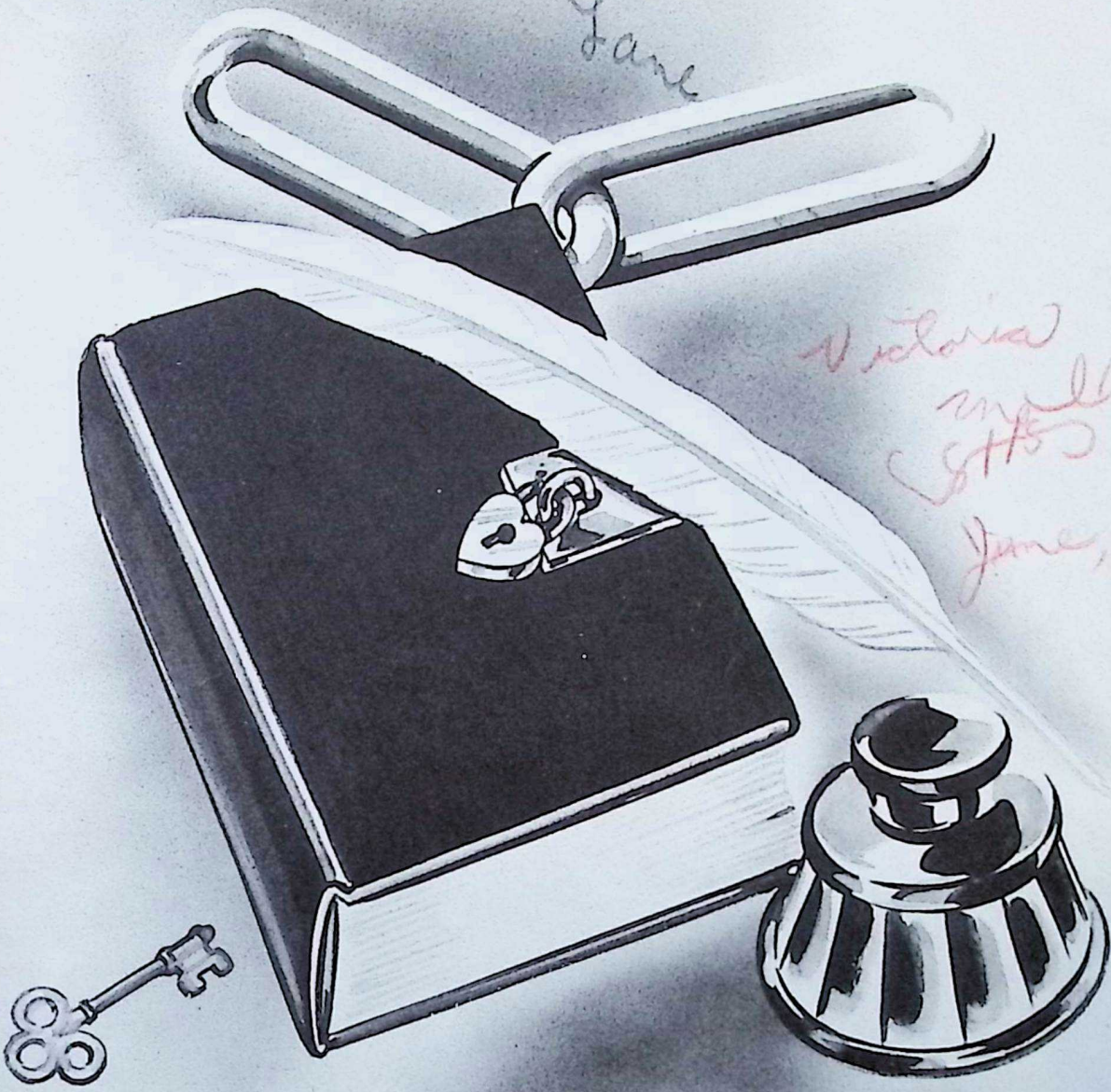
