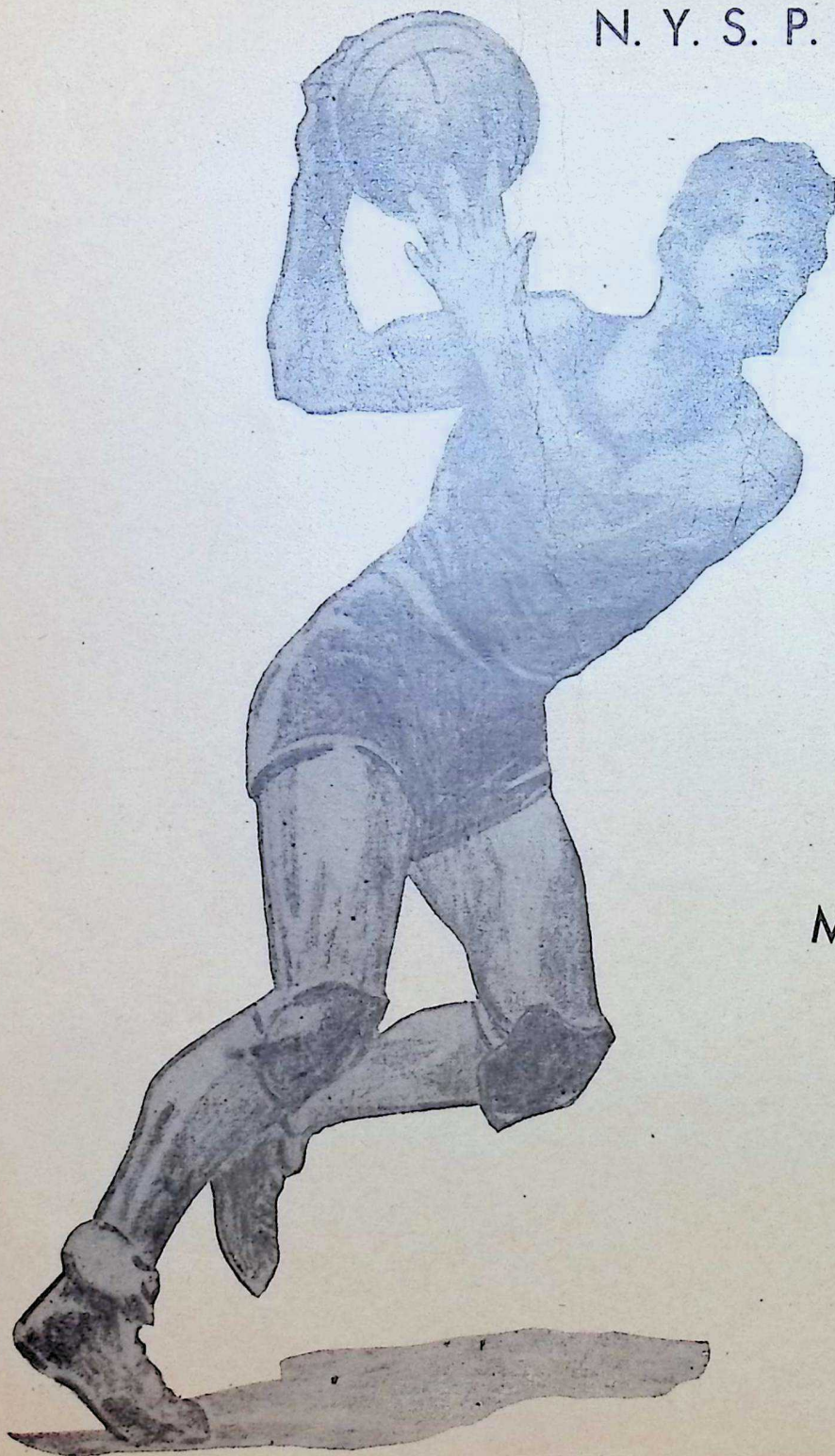

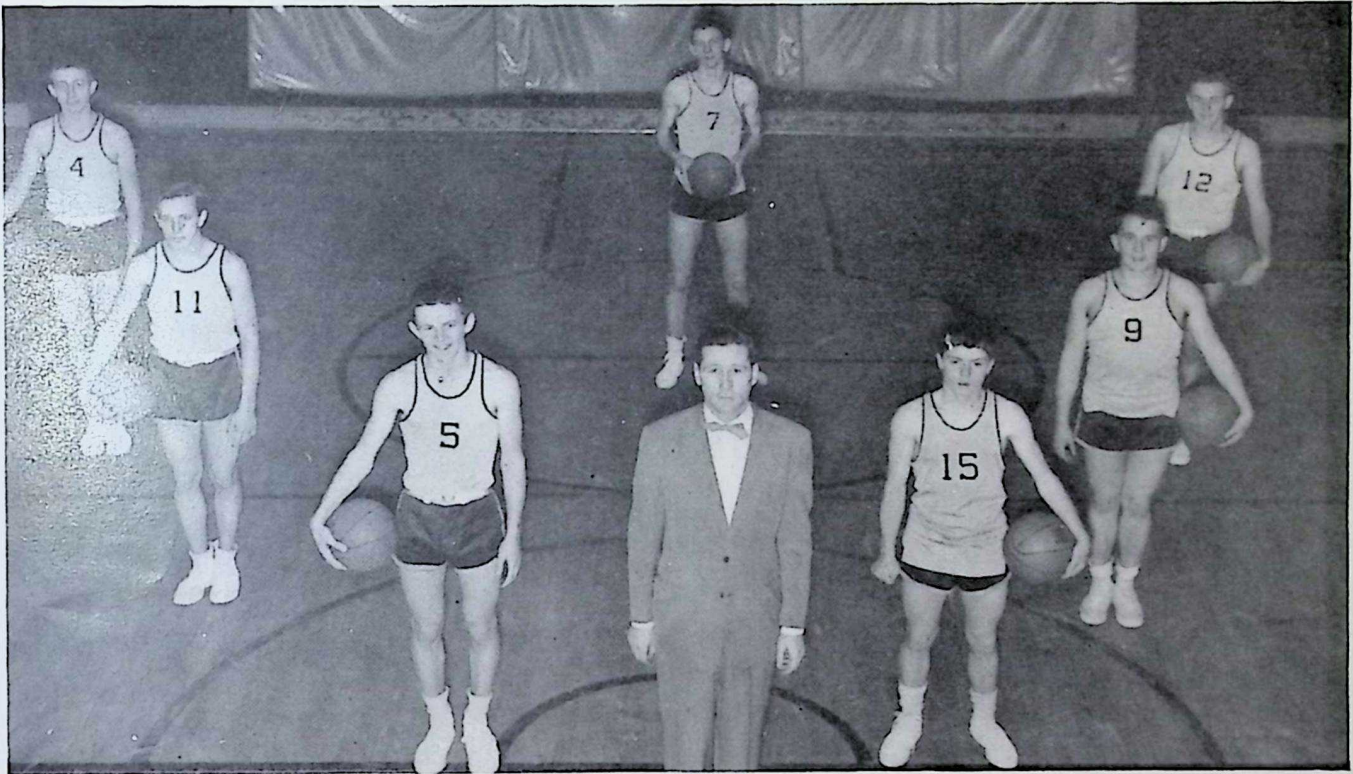

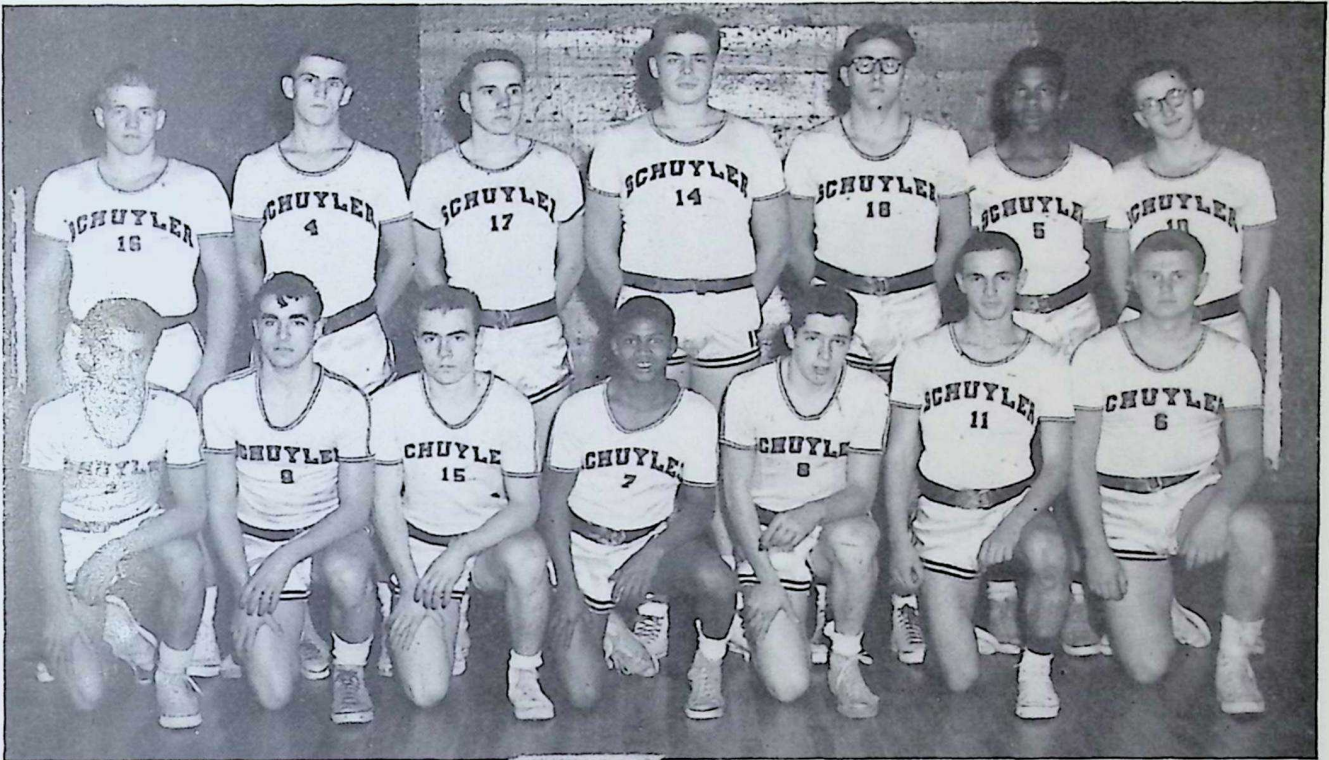

Schuyler comes into the Sectionals with a 13-5 season record and a 7-1 record in the Eastern "B" League, having lost the last game of the season to Hudson in a 75-73 thriller.

This is the highest scoring team Schuyler has ever produced, having run up 1260 points for an average of 70 points per game.

Captain Bill Telasky has been the big scoring threat of the Falcons all season amassing a total of 355 points for an average of 19.7 per game. He is closely followed by Arnie Busold and Ron Floser each of whom compiled 13 point averages and played excellently off the boards. Rounding out the starting five are the fast small men Vince DiMura

and Larry Dedrick. Capable replacements are Joe Carmello, Steve Weinlein, Bobby McCann and Johnny Fauth while up from the J. V. team is Ted Romanowski the biggest boy on the squad, Irving Brandon and Paul Cornelius. Earlier this year Schuyler lost the services of Charlie Dickerson due to poor health.

For Schuyler this may be the last appearance in the Sectionals for some time to come since they lose everyone on the Varsity by graduation except Larry Dedrick and will have to depend on an entire J. V. unit next year. However, this year's Junior Varsity won 17 and lost 1 and it was an entirely sophomore squad so things may not be as bad as they look.

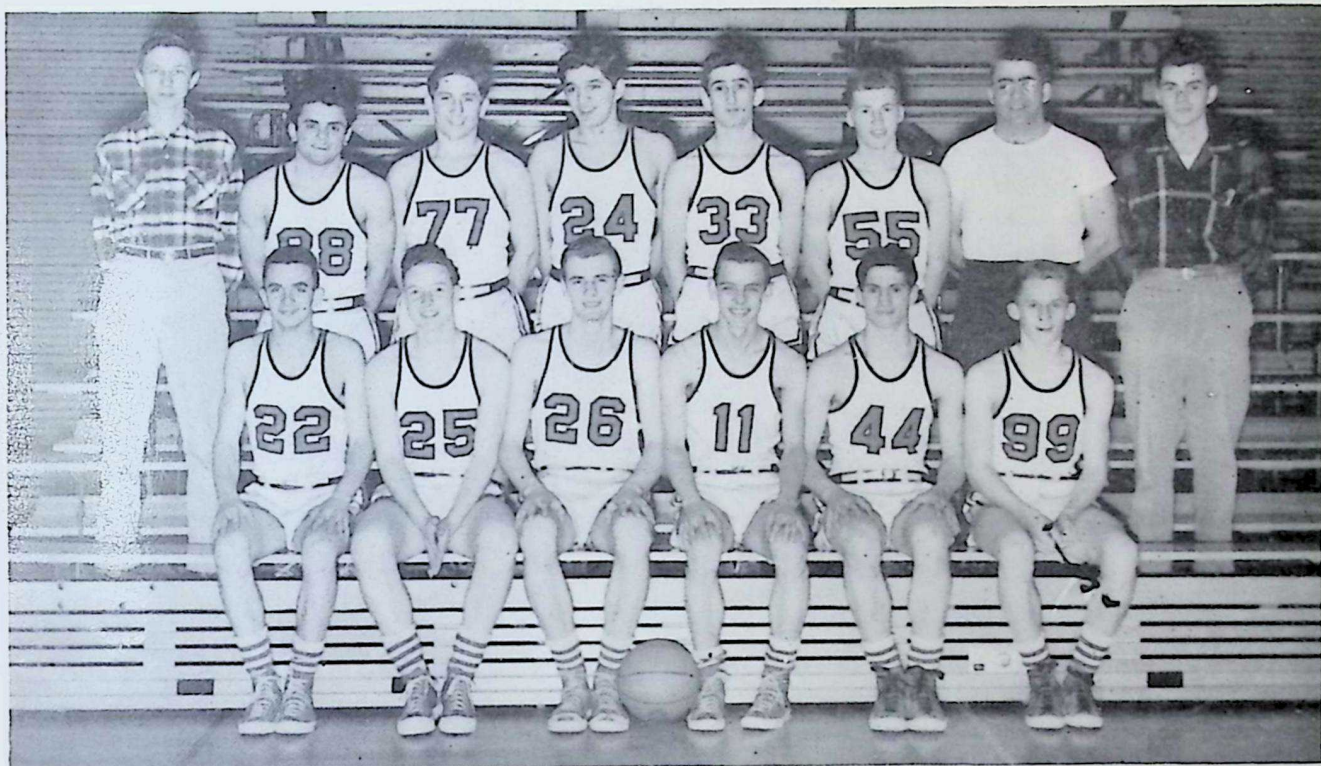

The team started slowly but gained momentum. We lost our first four games before beating Johnstown. Then we lost our next two games before gaining a victory over Troy High. This is about the time the team caught fire with eight wins and two losses after January 55-38 win over our arch rival Saratoga. We also gave Gloversville a rough time in both games losing by a total of 12 points in two games. Also we were never beaten twice by any one team except Gloversville. Coach Stanford Izzo, has

never coached a team which had more losses than wins.

Albert Fitch led the team in total points and in average. He had 186 total points and a 11-point average for 17 games. Mathew Anatriello had a 10-point average for 18 games, 186 total points. Louis Peluso led in foul shot percentage, 69 per cent, while Albert Fitch led in field goal percentage with 37 per cent. Mathew Antrillo led in fouls attempted with 103 also in fouls, made 62 per cent. The team shot for an average of 27 per cent on field goals and for an average of 53 per cent on foul shots.

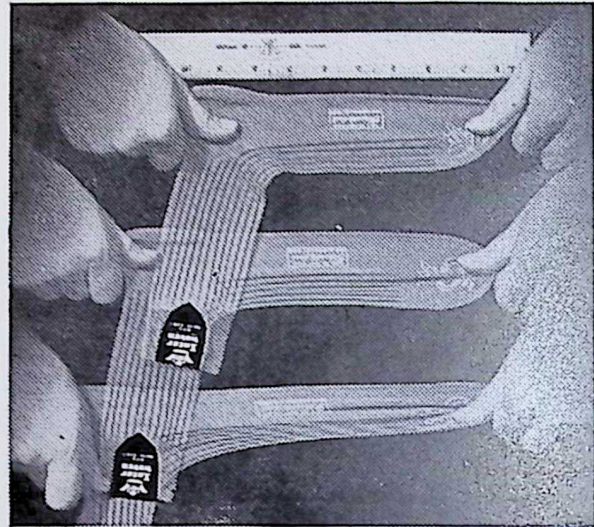
