Thank-you. The words sound hollow, but the thought is deep. I offer this yearbook to you, my parents, as evidence of my love and as appreciation for the life you have given me.



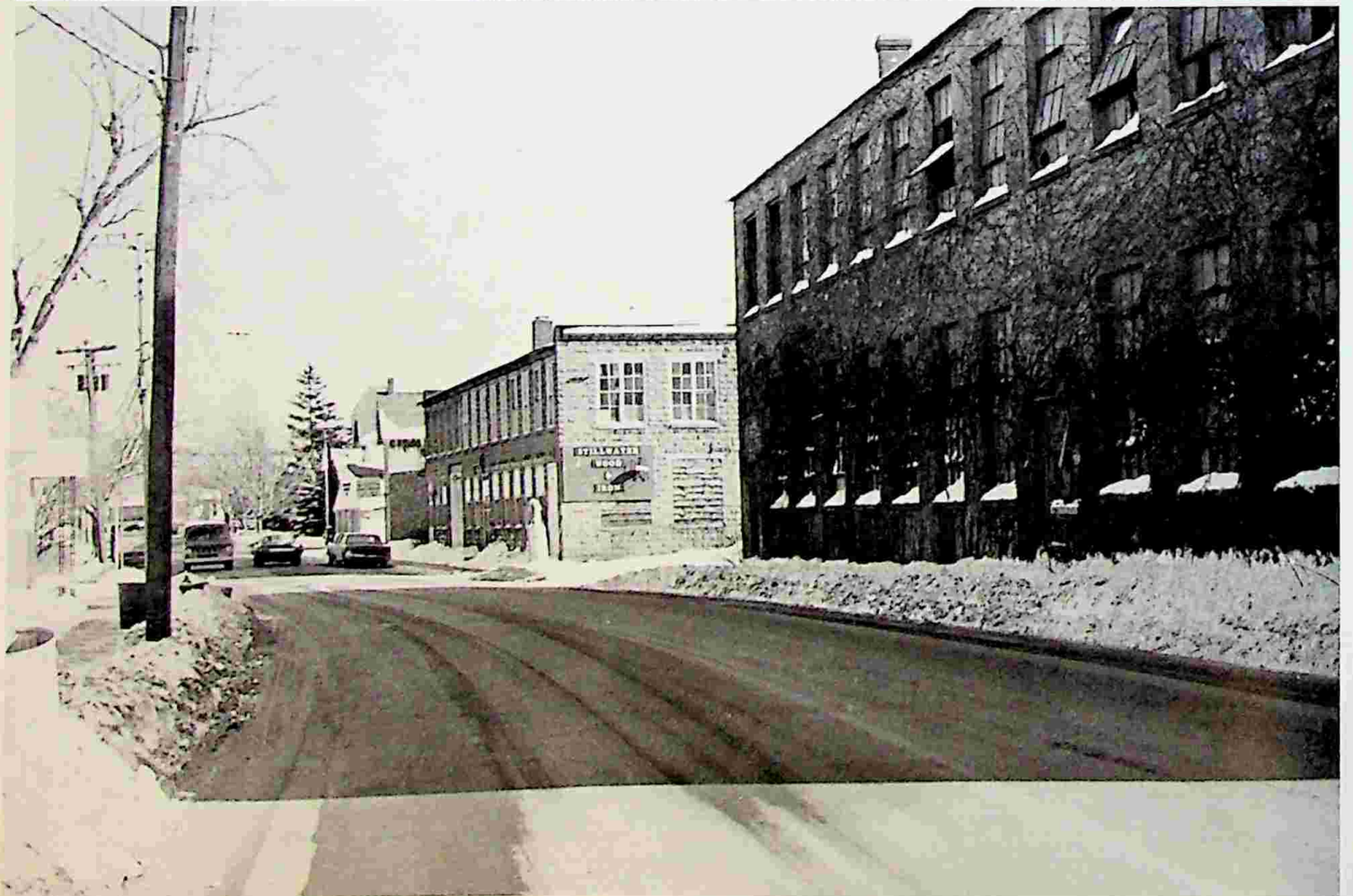
