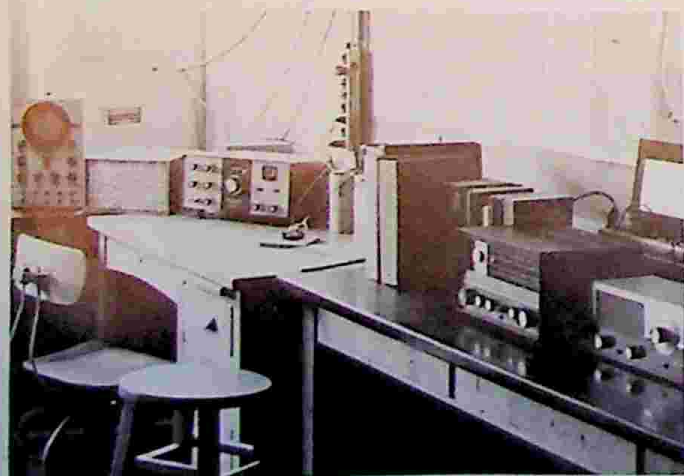
Students to examine ham radio

including one to Plattsburg University and one to Florida.

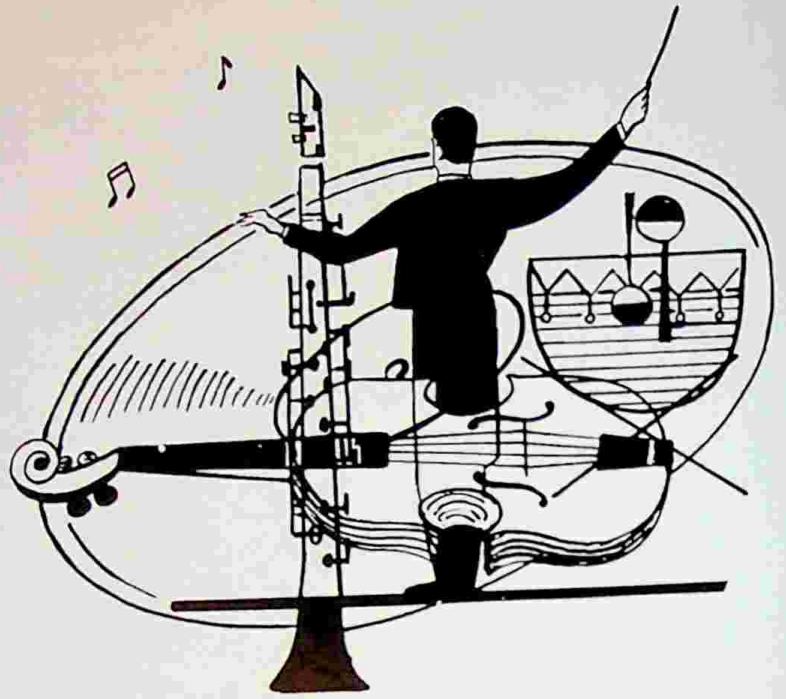

Cambridge girls edge Stillwater

STILLWATER — Claire Pender pumped in 18 points to lead Cambridge to a 63-49 triumph over Stillwater in a WASAREN League girls' varsity basketball game Friday.

Cambridge, which evened its record at 4-4, also got 14 points from Janet Hudson and 11 from Jo Ann Peters. Loraine Hathaway topped Stillwater, 2-6, with 11 points while Kim Waldron, Sal Herrick and Lynn Yandel added 10 points apiece.

Stillwater captured the jayvee game, 40-38.

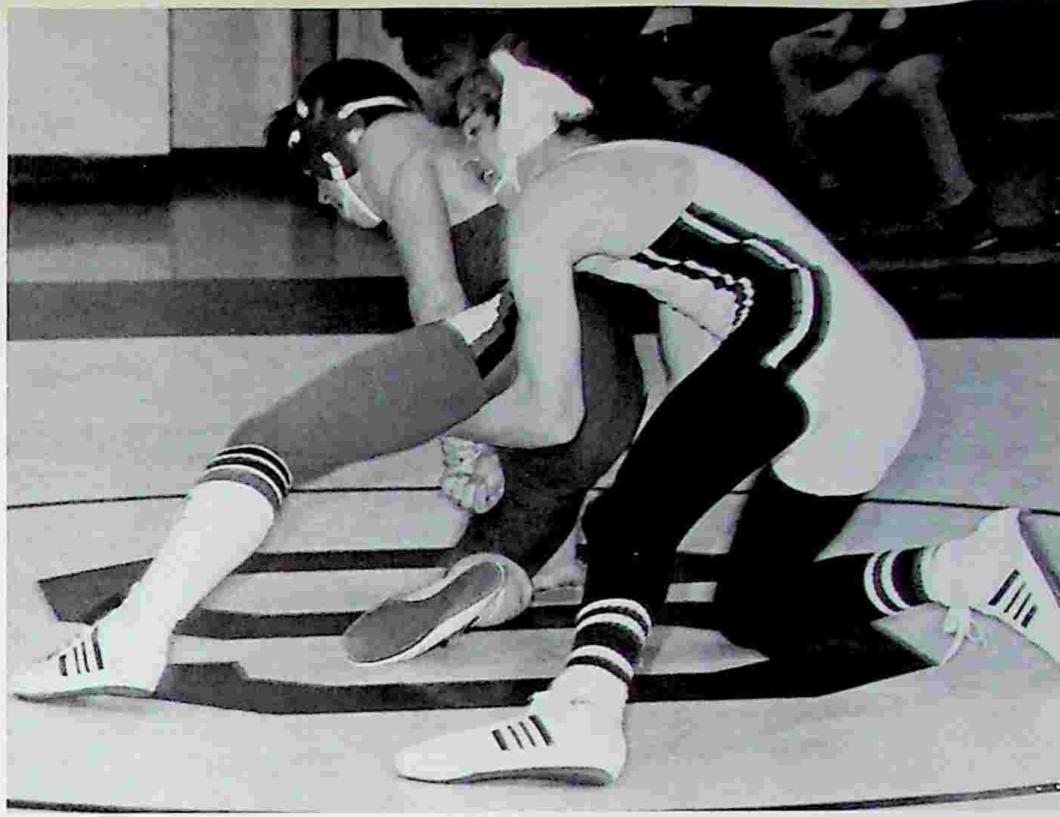
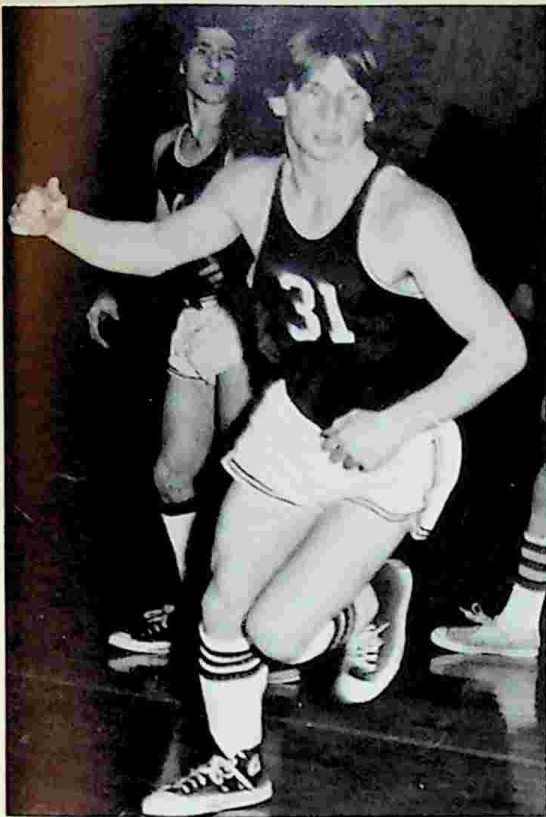


Fort Plain trailed Stillwater most of its contest, until Gerry Rouse led a Plain surge in the third quarter. The Warriors led, 39-33, at the intermission, but Rouse's eight third-quarter points propelled Fort Plain into a 55-53 lead with eight minutes to go. The winners used clutch foul-shooting to keep Stillwater at bay in the final quarter.

Dennis Smith led Fort Plain with 33 points, while Rouse added 16 markers. For Stillwater, senior Gibby Travis, who became the first 1,000-point scorer in the school's history, closed-out a brilliant career with 26 points. Tom Phillips contributed 18 to the losing effort.

Lake George led at each quarter stop in posting its win over Whitehall. The winners held leads of 13-10, 32-29 and 53-43. Walter Dorman and Scott Bombard paced Lake George with 15 and 14 points respectively. Bill Jeffreys led Whitehall with 21.

Deb Dennis rifled in 21 points to help Stillwater bounce Schuylerville, 71-26 in WASAREN girls basketball action Saturday.

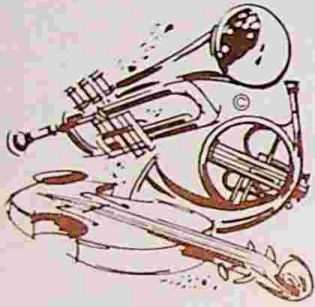
