Dramatics at Stillwater is a matter of serious fun. There is a rising crescendo of pressure from that first time you try out for your part to that fantastic moment of relief and exultation when the final curtain swings closed.

The performers rehearse in the six to eight weeks prior to public performance. In the beginning, there is the basic and all-important learning of lines. Following that comes the blocking of stage movements, the development of characters, interaction between characters, the mastering of bits of action, and, eventually, the unification of all into a total performance.

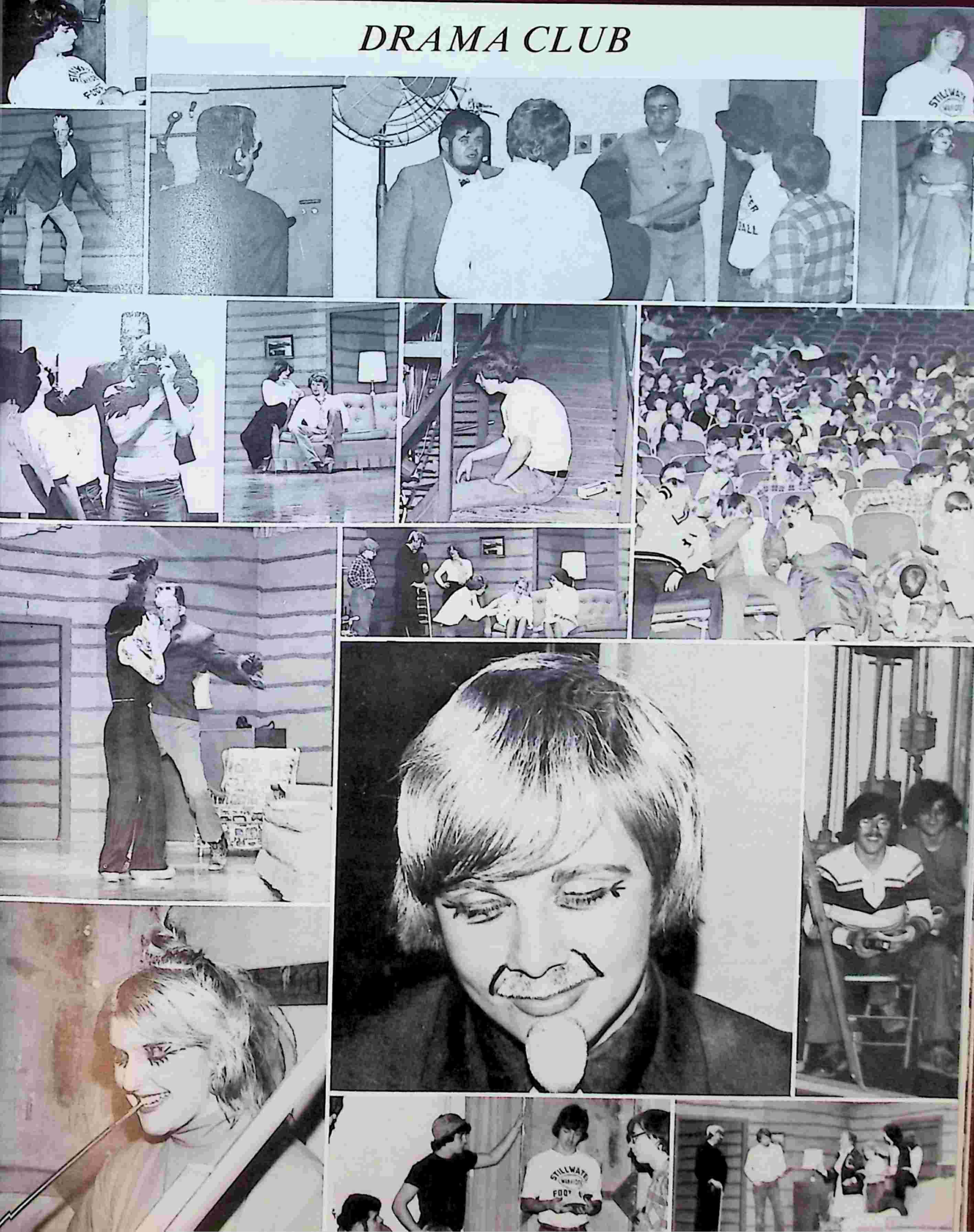
Meanwhile, back stage, a hard-working stage crew carries out the always difficult job of set construction. This includes the assembly of flats, construction of various segments of the set, painting, and, finally, the erection of the set on stage.

In addition, there are the problems of getting together appropriate props, setting the lights, and finding the right make-up and costumes.

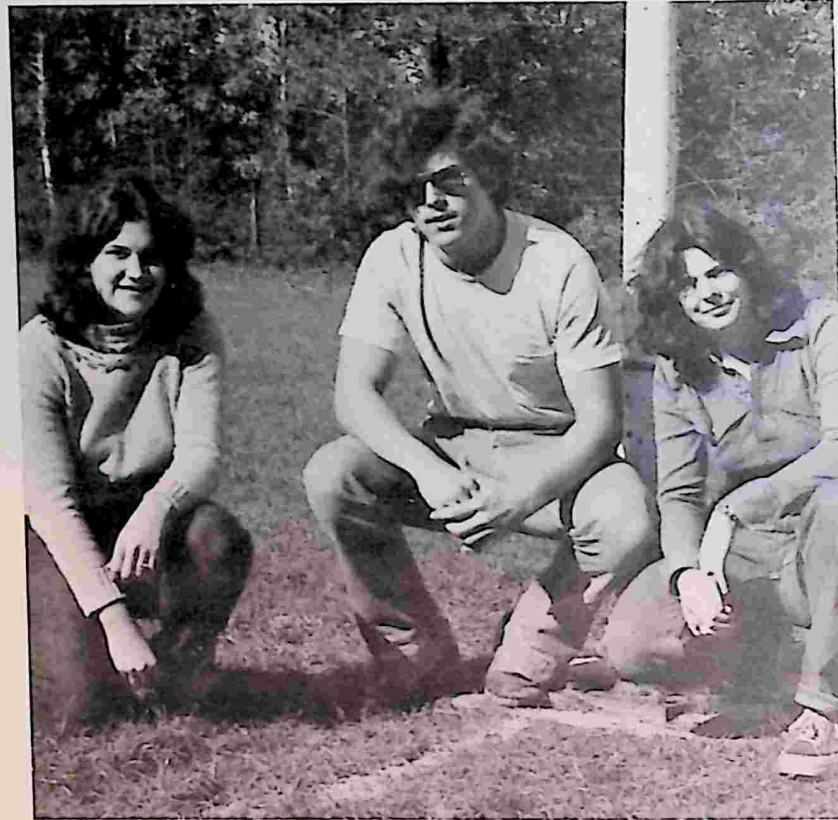
Dramatics is a great change-of-pace activity and a real challenge for the student who is not afraid of long hours and hard work. The pay-off is worth it.

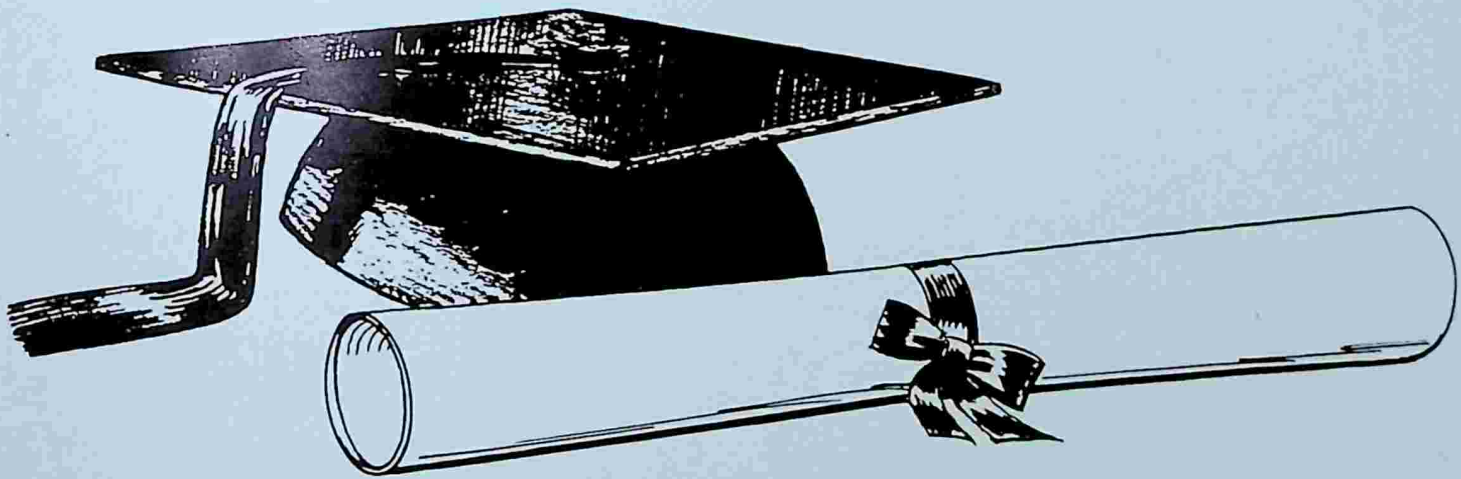

There is the expectation of both teachers and parents that he will be teachable, and being teachable is essentially wanting to grow in wisdom and understanding.

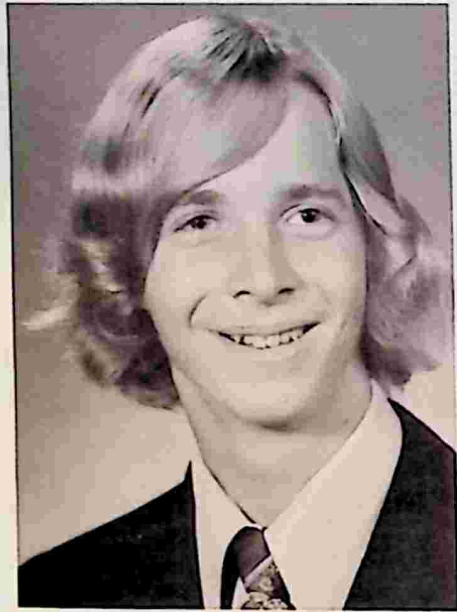
There are the citizens who expect him to be a good citizen, informed about the world with its variety of governments, but loyal to America.

There are the neighbors who expect him to be dependable, able to carry routine for a succession of days.

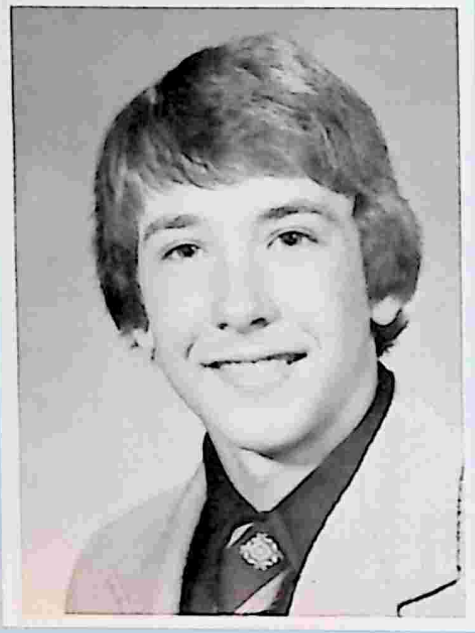
And there are those friends who expect him to have a special ability of understanding and caring for people, any people, all people.
