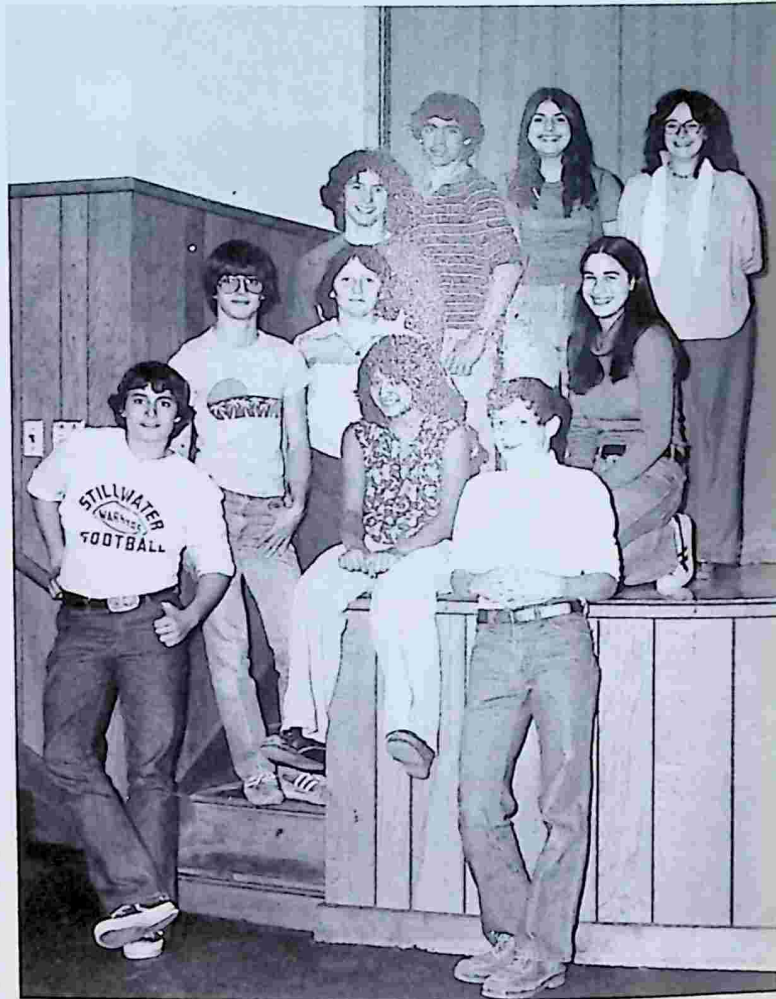
MATH LEAGUE
